

**Yearly Incentives
per Employee**

Designed to encourage companies expanding in or relocating to Colorado to hire remote workers in rural areas of the state, the Location Neutral Employee (LONE) grant is an established cash incentive for employers.

The incentive provides an income tax credit for all new jobs a company creates in the

state along with a cash grant for each remote employee the company hires to work in an eligible area like the Grand Valley.

Annual incentives depend on number of remote workers. Incentives begin at \$3,000/year and cap at \$6,500/year per employee.

Headquartered in Telluride, INFOCU5 made the decision to relocate its Pasadena, California-based operations and a dozen or so employees to Colorado's Grand Valley.
